Weather Summary/Alert:

In the last seven days (29 December - 4 January 2020), there was 14.2 mm rain and the sky was p-cloudy to overcast. The maximum & minimum temperatures ranged between 13.6 to 22.0°C and 1.4 to 12.9°C respectively. Relative humidity ranges from 88 to 97 % at 0712 a.m. and 36 to 77 % at 1412 hrs. The winds run mainly from the WSW at a speed of 1.1 to 7.0 km/hour. Very light to light rain may likely occur on 5, 6 & 8 January. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 21.0 to 22.0 deg C & 7.0 to 11.0 deg C respectively.
