Weather Summary/ Alert:

In the upcoming days light rainfall of 10 mm has been predicted on 11 January. Maximum & minimum temperature may be 14.0-15.0 degree Celsius & 5.0-6.0 degree Celsius, respectively. Wind is expected to blow with a speed of 2-3 km/hr primarily from the North-West from South-East direction. Light to moderate rain is likely to occur at few places on 11January. Dry weather is likely to prevail during rest of the period. A yellow warning regarding occurrence of thunderstorm accompanied with lightening is likely to occur at isolated places.

General Advisory:

The weather forecast and agrometeorological advisory is regularly updated on the "Meghdoot App" and "Damini App" is also available to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini apps can be downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Center (iOS users). The NDVI composite shows moderate agricultural vigour in the region. The extended range forecast system indicates deficient rainfall and above normal maximum-minimum temperature trend.

SMS Advisory:

As per IMD forecast, light rainfall is expected so all farming operations should be scheduled accordingly. Irrigation and chemical applications should be scheduled as per the forecast.

Crop Specific Advisory:

Crop (Varieties)	Stage	Crop Specific Advisory
Chickpea/Lentil	Vegetative	The crop should be monitored and regular hoeing and weeding operations should be done. All farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.
Rapeseed (Lahi/Ghariya) and Yellow Mustard (Rada)	Vegetative/ flowering	The crop should be monitored regularly. All farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.

Wheat	Vegetative	In rainfed conditions, weeding and hoeing should be monitored in the crop. All farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.
Barley	Vegetative	The crop should be monitored regularly for hoeing and weeding and all farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

Horticulture (Varieties)	Stage	Horticulture Specific Advisory
Capsicum	Nursery	Seeds should be sown in the prepared nursery and seedlings should be protected from frost and all farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.
Spinach	Vegetative	The crop should be protected against frost and all farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.
Potato	Vegetative	At 30-35 days interval remaining nitrogen need to be added after earthing up in potato and all farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast.

Live Stock Specific Advisory

Livestock	Live Stock Specific Advisory
Cow/Buffalo	To save the animal from cold, increase the amount of oil and Jaggery (Gur) in the food of animals. Caraway (Ajwain) and gur also be given to the animals. To save the animals from cold, proper arrangement of animal shed should be done. Vaccination should be given to the animals to save them from Rinderpest disease (Sheetla rog). The animal feed should be increased by 10% for extra energy requirement.
Sheep/Goat	Keep the delivery chambers of sheep/goats clean and neat.
