Weather Summary/Alert:

Weather will remain clear in the coming five days but light rain may likely occur today and wind will blow with a speed of 6.0-8.0 km/hr from the NNW direction. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 16.0 to 24.0 deg C & 4.0 to 9.0 deg C respectively. As per ERFS products, rainfall will be normal and max & min temperature will be below normal from 23-29 April and for the period from 30 April to 6 May rainfall will remain above normal, and maximum & minimum temperature will be below normal in the state . Thunderstorms accompanied with hail/lightning are likely to occur at isolated places today.

General Advisory:

In view of the severe spread of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India, personal hygiene, use of masks, washing hands at appropriate intervals during agricultural operations. NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.1-0.35 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly dry conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks.

Weather will remain clear in the coming five days. Light rain and thunderstorms accompanied with hail/lightning are likely to occur at isolated places today.
