Weather Summary/Alert:

Light to moderate rain may likely occur in the coming five days. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 21.0 to 23.0 deg C & 13.0 to 14.0 deg C respectively. Wind will blow with a speed of 6.0 km/hr from the SE direction. As per ERFIS products, rainfall & minimum temperature will be above normal and maximum temperature will be normal from 29 September - 5 October in the state. Warning: Heavy rainfall with intense spells likely occur at isolated places on 27 & 28 September and thunderstorms accompanied by lightning and intense showers at isolated places in hills in the coming five days.

General Advisory:

NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.1-0.45 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly dry conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks.

SMS Advisory:

Keeping in view the forecast of light to moderate rain in the coming days, the spraying of chemicals should be postponed, and maintain the drainage in the field. Keep harvested crops a safe place.

RICE	Do not let the paddy earhead touch the water or soil. Maintain a proper level of water in the field from flowering to grain filling. One week before harvesting, remove the water from the crop field and store the harvested crop in a safe place.
OKRA/ LADYFINGER	Fluck the okra fruits and send them to the market.
CARROT	In the valley, sowing of carrots should be done by keeping in view the weather forecast.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

CAULIFLOWER	Sowing of a late variety of cauliflower can be done. Sowing should be done based on the weather forecast.
SPINACH	Sow spinach in Bhabar and Valley region in September and October.

Live Stock Specific Advisory:

Live Stock(Varieties)	Live Stock Specific Advisory
BUFFALO	Vaccination of FMD (Foot and Mouth Disease) should be given to the animals.
