General Advisory:

NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.15-0.35 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the severely wet conditions in the district for the past 4 week
