Weather Summary/Alert:

Weather will remain clear in the coming five days but very light rain may likely occur from 29 April to 1 May and wind will blow with a speed of 6.0-8.0 km/hr from the NNW direction. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 26.0 to 27.0 deg C & 12.0 to 13.0 deg C respectively. As per ERFS products, rainfall will be above normal and max & min temperature will be below normal from 2-8 May in the state. Thunderstorms accompanied with lightning are likely to occur at isolated places from 29 April to 1 May.

General Advisory:

In view of the severe spread of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India, personal hygiene, use of masks, washing hands at appropriate intervals during agricultural operations. NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.15-0.3 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly dry conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks.

Weather will remain clear in the coming five days but there is a possibility of very light rain at some isolated places from 29 April to 1 May.
