Weather Summary/Alert:

In the last seven days (22–28 June, 2021), there was 0.0 mm rain and the sky was partly to dense cloudy. The maximum & minimum temperatures ranged between 33.0 to 35.5°C and 25.4 to 27.4°C respectively. Relative humidity ranges from 73 to 85 % at 0712 a.m. and 54 to 67 % at 1412 hrs. The winds run mainly from the ENE with a speed of 2.4 to 6.6 km/hour. Light to moderate rain may likely occur in the coming five days. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 32.0 to 36.0 deg C & 24.0 to 27.0 deg C respectively. Wind will blow with a speed of 12.0-16.0 km/hr from the ESE direction. As per ERFS products, rainfall will be below normal, maximum & minimum temperature will be normal from 4 - 10 July in the state. Warning: Heavy rainfall and thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and intense shower likely to occur at isolated places. Squall (50-60 kmph) likely to occur at isolated places.

General Advisory:

In view of the second wave of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India, personal hygiene, use of masks, washing hands at appropriate intervals during agricultural operations. NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.1-0.4 for Udham Singh Nagar i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly wet conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks.

SMS Advisory:

Light to moderate rain may likely occur in the coming five days.

RICE	Transplanting of paddy should be completed in the month of July and direct sowing of paddy can be done till the first week of July month.
	Keeping in view the rainfall forecast in the coming days, it is advised that proper drainage should be maintained in the field. When the crop growth is good, get it tied at a height of 5 feet.
	Sowing of late sown variety of pigeon pea should be completed till first fortnight of July month.

CAPSICUM	On the occurrence of collar rot in capsicum, spray Ridomil Gold @ 2 gm/li water along with sticker. Spraying of chemicals should be done in clear weather.
