Weather Summary/Alert:

Moderate rain may likely occur in the coming five days. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 17.0 to 20.0 deg C & 14.0 to 16.0 deg C respectively. Wind will blow with a speed of 6.0-8.0 km/hr from the ESE direction. As per ERFIS products, rainfall, maximum and minimum temperature will be normal from 4 - 10 August in the state. Warning: Heavy to very heavy rainfall with intense spells and thunderstorms/lightning are likely to occur at isolated places from 30 July-2 August.

General Advisory:

In view of the second wave of Corona (Covid-19), the farmers are advised to follow the guidelines given by the Government of India, personal hygiene, use of masks, washing hands at appropriate intervals during agricultural operations. NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.05-0.45 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly wet conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks. Farmers can download "Meghdoot" and "Damini" mobile apps on their smartphones from Google Play Store for free to get timely weather forecasts and district-wise Agromet advisory bulletins and lightning information.

SMS Advisory:

Moderate rain may likely occur in the coming five days. Warning: Heavy to very heavy rainfall with intense spells and thunderstorms/lightning are likely to occur at isolated places from 30 July-2 Aug

Crop Specific Advisory:

Crop(Varieties)	Crop Specific Advisory
MAIZE	Keeping in view the possibility of rain in the coming days, do not irrigate the maize crop.
OKRA/ LADYFINGER	To control the yellow vein mosaic virus, remove and destroy the infected plants.
FINGER MILLET	Keep monitoring the crops and remove weeding should be done in the crop if necessary.
SOYABEAN	Weeding and hoeing should be done in the crop by keeping in view the weather forecast.

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

Horticulture(Varieties)	Horticulture Specific Advisory
CAPSICUM	In hilly regions, proper drainage should be maintained in the field of capsicum crop during monsoon season and fruit picking should be done timely.
CHILLI	Proper drainage should be maintained in the field of chilli crop because if water remains in the field for 24 hours, the crop dries up.

BUFFALO	Rainwater should not be given to animals. To save the animals from infected diseases, vaccination should be done on the recommendation of a veterinarian.
