Research Projects Position-1:Sustainability value analysis of Indian food supply chains

The project aims to investigate sustainability performance within selected Indian import food supply chains by identifying and addressing the non-value-adding activities that lead to waste, delays, and waiting times. An ideal student for this project must have knowledge about sustainability in food systems and Indian food supply chains, access to stakeholders for data collection, and the ability to use advanced data analysis methods.

Research Projects Position-2:Technology-driven resilience strategies for food supply chains

COVID-19 disruptions were a test for many supply chains on robustness and resilience. Many organisations have adapted their supply chains after the pandemic. This project investigates how firms in the food supply chain have used technology to increase supply chain robustness and the factors influencing technology adoption decisions. An ideal student for this project must have good knowledge of local food supply chains, technology use, access to firms in the Indian food supply chains for data collection, and the ability to utilise advanced data analysis methods.
